## Content of the Correlation Tables

The tables contain the following columns.

Column Name	Description
Message Element	For each data group, the full hierarchical name is shown. For each data item, the full name of the data item, consisting of the data group name (full hierarchical name) to which the data item belongs and the name of the data item itself.
Data Type	The format of the data item.
Codelist	The reference to the codelist as defined in DDNTA for NCTS P5 Appendix C.
Messages	For each message in NCTS P5 , one column is foreseen to indicate if the data-item or data-group is (O)ptional, (R)equired or (D)ependent.
